School Resumes in 2014

Kindergarten Best Start Assessment

Kindergarten children will not start school as a whole class until Monday the 3rd February 2014. Individual Best Start testing allows for teachers to understand the students' individual learning needs and enables teachers to cater for each child's needs.
