Who is a child?

A child is defined as any person who has not yet turned 18 years ofage.

What happens to the consent form once it is filled out? The consent form will be placed on file and retained by EWB for at least year. If requested within 6 months of the form being signed, a copy of the form will be made available to the participant and/or the participant's parent or guardian.
