#### Medications

- All required medications must be clearly labelled with child's name, dosage and times for administering. These medications must be handed to Mrs Rogers on the morning of the excursion before departure.
- Medications must not be kept with the student unless it is an asthma puffer. Asthma puffers and spacers must be kept with the student at all times.
