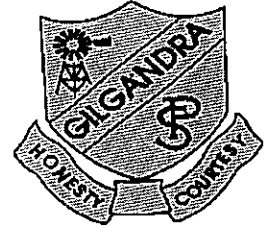




# Gilgandra Public School
