What will my child need to bring?

The school supplies all the classroom equipment that your child will need to grow and learn in Kindergarten Turtles this year however, if you would like to send in a paint smock to keep at school during those messy activities, please do so.

Please ensure your child has a packed lunch or lunch order each day along with some fresh fruit/ vegetables for our Crunch and Sip program in the mornings.
