'Gilgandra To Me, By Me'

Moments in my life as a child in Gilgandra

All students have been invited to create a short film based on an aspect of their life in Gilgandra. This is to be raw footage from the child's perspective.

The film should be no longer than 5 minutes. It should depict one area of the child's life or snippets of the entire day.

Examples may include;

- The long hot dusty walk to the bus stop followed by the bus ride.
- Feeding the chooks
- Walking the dog
- Family dinnertime - including the nagging and the giggles.
- Working on homework
- Playing at the skatepark

There are so many areas of life that could be the focus of the film.

Students should grab a phone or I-pad and start filming. Be the subject or the narrator.

We will run a few classes at school using I-movie to show how to chop and refine the footage taken.

There **must be no special effects used**, again the project outline is to be raw footage.

Students should upload their video to their Google Drive/Library Google Classroom to then be able to be collaborated with the school entries. Most videos will be shown to the school community. The top 5 entries will be shared with Gilgandra Film Festival for their community event in early May.
